Logo

Protecting the logo

The exclusion zone is illustrated by the broken line. Never breach this exclusion zone with graphics or text.

The logo must always be applied in the right scale.

The colour palette of the logo has been built around three versions which should be applied in accordance with the colour of the product.

ORIGINAL FILES OF THE LOGO

CMYK versions are intended for high-quality prints and printing.

RGB versions are intended for office and web applications.

Colours

The core colours are blue and white based on the Finnish flag. Accent colours can be used in addition to the core colours. There are two accent colours, warm orange and light beige. The accent colours should be used with moderation, in carefully considered details and in one or a maximum of two elements per entity. The purpose of the accent colours is to create a contrast and enrich the impact of the core colours.




PowerPoint template

The PowerPoint template includes a front, content and end page as well as a pull quote page to give rhythm to the presentation.

The template is available in two sizes, 16:9 and 4:3.

When there are multiple cooperation partners, their logos are grouped on an empty page after the front page.










Content page with automatic scaling of text size


Content page with two columns




Content page with two columns and a place for image and graph

Seminar badge


These are examples

Roll-up and screen

Roll-ups can be made on stands varying in width from 85 to 100 cm.

The images of possible cooperation partners are grouped one below another on the bottom left.

A screen with a basic size of 240 cm in width and 229 cm in height is available for use at events and trade fairs.

Two additional panels 80 cm wide can be added to each side of the screen. Thus the screen's maximum width is 560 cm.

The screen is bendable, so it can be shaped for instance to form a semicircle.

Team Finland network badge

Team Finland organisations can bring out their connection with the network by adding the so-called Team Finland network badge to their communication materials.

The badge does not require a peaceful background; instead it can be placed on any background, e.g. on a picture. The badge is always placed on the edge of the document.

In principal, the badge with blue background should be used. If it is unsuitable, there is a neutral colour alternative. The blue colour is then replaced with gray/white. In this case, 60% black is used.



The side of the badge that aligns to the cut edge of the material should be extended beyond document trim edges in order to cut away properly.

free corner.


On publications the badge
