



#### Age structure of population on 31 December




# Population and population projection by age group



#### Live births and deaths













#### Employment rate, persons aged 15 to 64




## Unemployed, aged 15 to 74





#### Demographic dependency ratio by municipality, 2019







#### Annual change in the volume of gross domestic product














# Real price development of selected food items



#### Index of wage and salary earnings by employer sector









#### Housing benefits















#### Municipal waste by treatment method





#### **Total energy consumption**








