To the reader

In an international comparison Finland was selected the happiest country in the world for the seventh time in a row (World Happiness Report 2024). Is happiness visible in the statistics?

Although Finland is a small country, making up 0.07 per cent of the world's population and the world's surface area, it does quite well in international statistical comparisons. Finland's statistical system was ranked the best in the world in the World Bank's comparison already for the second time.

Finland in Figures 2024 is a review of us and our society – including all permanent residents of Finland and their homes, jobs, pay, education, pensions, free-time residences or cars.







Development of population, 1750–2023




Population and population projection by age group














Gross domestic product per capita, 1975–2023*

Annual change in the volume of gross domestic product, 1976–2023*





General government deficit/surplus and debt, 1975–2023*























Municipal waste by treatment method






